JOCKEY CHANGES

Race 6, Jockey A L Da Silva was replaced by Jockey R Joorawon on HENRY TUDOR.

Race 8, Jockey A Andrews was replaced by Jockey R Joorawon on SECRET CIRCLE.

Stewards' Reports

BONJOUR BABY (I Taka) and STREET BYTE (MP De Oliveira) were restless in the stalls.

At the start, ITALIAN WAY (B Sooful) jumped awkwardly outwards and caused a chain reaction in which BONJOUR BABY (I Taka), STREET BYTE (M P De Oliveira) and THE RIGHT STUFF (S Rama) shifted out. In this incident, STREET BYTE made contact with CELESTIAL MAGMA (J De Souza), was squeezed out and then STREET BYTE was steadied off the heels of CELESTIAL MAGMA (J De Souza).

CELESTIAL MAGMA (J De Souza) hung in, in the straight.

Jockey D Schwarz (SACRED NIGHT) was questioned with regards to him becoming unbalanced in the straight, particularly in the concluding stages of the race and it seemed that the Jockey could not assist his horse properly. Jockey D Schwarz explained that his horse was leaning in and whilst trying to keep his horse run straight. However, whilst endeavoring to get SACRED NIGHT to the finish, he unbalanced himself. The Board noted the explanations of Jockey D Schwarz and advised him that his riding will continue to be monitored.

Jockey J De Souza (CELESTIAL MAGMA) was observed to have used his whip in consecutive strides in the running prior to the 100m. He was found in contravention of Rule 147(6)(a)(i), in that, he admitted to have struck the horse, CELESTIAL MAGMA, more than once on consecutive strides in the running and signed an admission of guilt. Consequently, a penalty of Rs 3000 was imposed on him.

SACRED NIGHT – Not striding out.

YOHO MIST (J Da Silva) and DUNZIE (M P De Oliveira) were fractious in the stalls.

At the start, HONOKALANI (L Goomany) was slow. NOBLE TRIP (A L Da Silva) was slow by a length and CAPTAIN FALCON (S Bussunt) was further slow.

Approaching the 800m, HONOKALANI (L Goomany) scraped the rails.

CAPTAIN FALCON (S Bussunt) raced keen near the 500m was steadied while going over the crossing at the 450m.

Near the 300m, CHARLIE SQUADRON (A Andrews) gave ground while racing on the heels of YOHO MIST (J Da Silva) due to which HONOKALANI (L Goomany), that was following, had to be steadied, switched out, carrying DUNZIE (MP De Oliveira) outwards.

In the concluding stages of the race, HONOKALANI (L Goomany) shifted out and took the running of MAGNUM P I (N Teeha).

Jockey N Teeha (MAGNUM P I) has been advised not to extend his arm out while riding.

At the start, STAR OF ZEUS (A Andrews) was slow by three lengths and CHOSEN WAY (S Bussunt) was slow into its stride, losing ground.



Jockey C Maujean (SYDS LIASON) reported that his horse was finding it difficult to keep up with the pace and he had to ask for an effort every now and then throughout the race. The horse was referred to the Veterinary Surgeon.

CHOSEN WAY (S Bussunt) was hanging in, in the last 100m of the race. Trainer Gujadhur has been advised to rectify the trait of this horse.

STAR OF ZEUS (A Andrews) did not have a clear run in the concluding stages while racing between DROP KICK (D Schwarz) and CHOSEN WAY S Bussunt) when both the horses shifted ground, though the incident did not have any material effect on the result of the race.

Jockey M P De Oliveira (STREAM AHEAD) carried 1.0kg overweight and weighed out at 55.5 kg.

Jockey A Andrews (PADRE PIO) carried 1.0kg overweight and weighed out at 53 kg.

Jockey K Teetan (TRIPPI'S EXPRESS) claimed 0.5kg of his 1.5kg Allowance.



STREAM AHEAD (MP De Oliveira) was hanging in over the final 200m placing his rider at a disadvantage in riding his mount out to the finish. Further, Trainer C Daby will be advised to rectify this trait of the gelding.

Jockey L Goomany (NOURBESE) reported that his horse was intimidated by the presence of STREAM AHEAD (M P De Oliveira) on its outside in close proximity. Further, Jockey L Goomany reported loss of his whip in the concluding stages as his whip made contact with STREAM AHEAD.

Stewards' Reports

The Clerk of Scales reported that Jockey A L Da Silva (HENRY TUDOR) was weighing out at 56kg which was 2.0kg over the carded weight, however, he was permitted to carry only 1.0kg overweight. In view of this, a change of Jockey was permitted and Jockey R Joorawon replaced Jockey A L Da Silva.

Subsequently, Trainer S Hurchund, Jockey A L Da Silva, along with his translator, were questioned in this regard. Evidence was taken from Trainer C Daby also. The Jockey was found guilty of contravening Rule 160 of the Rules of Racing, in that, he had accepted a ride whilst he was overweight. As a consequence, a fine of Rs 2500 was imposed on him and he was advised of his right to appeal.

ZIVA LA WINTER (B Sooful) proved difficult to load into the gates. This horse has been suspended for 7 days, after which it will be required to pass a Barrier Trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards.

At the start, VALYRIAN KING (J Allyhosain) was slow to begin.

At the start, ALRAMZ (L Goomany) and HENRY TUDOR (R Joorawon) brushed, whilst gaining balance ALRAMZ shifted in due to which ZIVA LA WINTER (B Sooful) was steadied.



Leaving the 600m, ALRAMZ (L Goomany) was restrained and then near the 450m crossing checked, due to CARTEL BOSS (A Andrews) shifting in. An inquiry has been opened into the interference.

Jockey B Sooful (ZIVA LA WINTER) reported that his face hit the horse's head in the stalls and he was on the verge of blacking out, but somehow finished the race.

MARAUDING (S Rama) was wide at the home turn and lugged in, in the straight.

The race was delayed as the off-fore shoe of GO JEWEL (D Schwarz) came off and was refitted.

ALASKAN NIGHT (J Da Silva) and GANG LEADER (N Teeha) were restless in the stalls.

Near the 300m, GOOD BUDDY (C Maujean) clipped heels of JAYS DANCER (J De Souza) and lost position.

Near 200m, SPRY (J Allyhosain) was ridden from the outside of ALASKAN NIGHT (J Da Silva) and GANG LEADER (N Teeha) hung-in and brushed with SPRY (J Allyhosain). At the same time, ALASKAN NIGHT commenced to hang-out, causing SPRY to switch in.

In the concluding stages, ALASKAN NIGHT (J Da Silva) and GANG LEADER (N Teeha) brushed.

The Medical Officer attended to Jockey A Andrews after the race and declared him unfit to ride and accordingly, Jockey A Andrews was replaced for his remaining engagement.

Jockey A Andrews was replaced by Jockey R Joorawon.

At the start, CRAZY CHARLIE (B Sooful) was slow.

At the start, ROMANUS (S Bussunt) shifted out after an awkward jump and went on to SECRET CIRCLE (R Joorawaon) who went on to INAUGURATION (A Roy). INAUGURATION had also shifted in as GLOBAL SPECTRUM (M Sonaram) shifted in and brushed with INAUGURATION (A Roy).

Prior to the 1300m, GLOBAL SPECTRUM (M Sonaram) was eased off the heels of SAND PATH (MP De Oliveira).

Near the 1000m, SAND PATH (MP De Oliveira) was urged to move forward and in the process inconvenienced TALISMAN (D Schwarz) on its inside.

Near the 200m, SAND PATH (MP De Oliveira) hung out and carried OPAGUE (J Allyhosain) outwards who then went across ROMANUS (S Bussunt) causing the latter to be steadied.

Further, Trainer C Daby will be advised to rectify the trait of SAND PATH.

SUPPLEMENTARY REPORT FROM RACES RUN ON 11TH SEPTEMBER 2022

RACE MEETING 20 – PEOPLES' TURF PLC LTD

An inquiry was held at the Office of the Horse Racing Division on 16th September 2022 with regard to the use of Blinkers for the first time without a test on ABSOLUTIST and CRIMSON GOD in the 3rd and 8th race respectively. Trainer A Sewdyal was interviewed. The Stewards did not pursue the matter as far as ABSOLUTIST was concerned.

Mr. A Sewdyal pleaded not guilty, however, he was found guilty of the contravention of Rule 115 (g) of the Rules of Racing, in that, no horse may be entered to race unless when it is to race for the first time in blinkers has undergone a test at the starting gates prior to racing. Consequently, a fine of Rs.5000 was imposed on Trainer A Sewdyal.

Trainer A Sewdyal was advised of his right to Appeal.
