3. SERIOUS BUSINESS (K. Roussety) raced wide throughout. Thereafter, at the 500 m , SERIOUS BUSINESS refused to take the turn and pulled itself out of the race notwithstanding the urgings of Apprentice K. Roussety. In view of this report, SERIOUS BUSINESS has been suspended from racing for 30 days and until proving tractable in the running.
4. Apprentice I. Taka (MISTY ROLLER) was unable to weigh out at the carded weight. Consequently, after hearing an application from Trainer C. Daby for Apprentice I. Taka to maintain the ride, the Board granted him permission to ride MISTY ROLLER. However, Apprentice I. Taka signed an admission of guilt for a contravention of Rule 32.4, in that he weighed out at more than 1 kg over the weight at which he was carded to ride. Accordingly, a penalty of a fine of Rs 5,000 was imposed.
5. Jockey K. Ramsamy reported that GONTRAVELIN did not stride out freely in the running. In view of this report, the Veterinary Surgeon was requested to examine.
6. In view of the performance of SOCKEROO (N. Batchameah), the Veterinary Surgeon was requested to examine.
7. Apprentice N. Batchameah signed an admission of guilt for a contravention of Rule 22.12, in that he failed to present himself to the Clerk of Scales and be in the jockey's quarters at
least one (1) hour prior to his first engagement. Accordingly, a penalty of a fine of Rs 5,000 was imposed.

3. At the 400 m , SAN ANDREAS (M. De Oliveira) elected to switch out from the position on the rail and was able to secure a narrow run between MANETHEREN (D. Bheekary) and BOLLINGER (C. Goolgar), which rolled out marginally.
4. Apprentice C. Goolgar signed an admission of guilt for a contravention of Rule 29.2.5, in that he struck the horse BOLLINGER with his whip more than once on consecutive strides in the running. Accordingly, a penalty of a fine of Rs 2,500 was imposed.

2. At the 700m, PROSPECTOR (B. Sooful) was brushed out by BACKPACKER (D. Bheekary), which rolled out.
3. Approaching the 300 m , CHOSEN WAY (M. De Oliveira) raced wide around the turn and into the straight.
4. In view of the performance of CHRISTMAS BAY (I. Taka) and DIVERGENT (K. Ramsamy), the Veterinary Surgeon was requested to examine.
5. SECRET OASIS (R. Perez) was hanging in, in the concluding stages.
6. Jockey R. Perez (SECRET OASIS) appeared before the Board and was afforded an opportunity to place on record any factors which in his view contributed to the defeat of SECRET OASIS.

In this regard, he explained to the Board that after jumping well and obtaining a comfortable lead, SECRET OASIS had raced greenly in the running at various points but in particular at the 1100 m when this gelding shifted out after racing over the crossing and having to be directed in and, in the concluding stages, when it was hanging in. Additionally, he explained that SECRET OASIS losing a shoe had, in his view, materially impacted the performance of this gelding.

When questioned regarding whether SECRET OASIS had stayed the distance after the speed Jockey R. Perez had gone in the race, he explained that in his view SECRET OASIS had certainly stayed the distance and from his knowledge of the horse, the speed was comfortable.

Jockey R. Perez stated in closing that had SECRET OASIS not lost a shoe in his view, it would have won the race. The Board noted the explanations of Jockey R. Perez.
