General Report

The Stipendiary Stewards of the HRD inspected the track at 07.10 am along with the Clerk of the Course, PTP track manager, PTP CEO, some Trainers and Jockeys and having taken random penetrometer reading between the 700m to 450m, after having obtained a general consensus, decided to continue with the conduct of race meeting 43. However, feedback from the Jockeys was to be obtained after each race to determine the suitability of the track for racing to continue.

Starting Reports

1. CRACKON (K. Ramsamy) was slowly away.

Stewards Reports

- 1. Leaving the stalls, CRACKON (K. Ramsamy) was squeezed out.
- UNITED PRINCE (J.Allyhosain), AFRICAN FATE (C.Segeon) and CRACKON (K.Ramsamy) were wide at the 1200m.
- 3. CIDER HOUSE RULES (I.Taka) was hanging in, in the straight.
- 4. AL JAZEERA (M.De Oliveira) was held up for a clear run while racing on the inside of CIDER HOUSE RULES (I.Taka) from the 150m to the 100m.
- 5. The whip of Apprentice I. taka (CIDER HOUSE RULES) made contact with the face of AL JAZEERA (M.De Oliveira) on more than one occasion, between the 150m and the 100m.
- 6. Jockey J. Bardottier (CAPKUTA) advised that he did not persevere with his horse in the straight as his horse did not travel well during the race.

After the running of the 1st race, all the Jockeys appeared before the Stewards and were unanimous in advising the Stewards that the track was unsafe for racing. Subsequently, the Trainers appeared before the Stewards and were willing to give the HRO some time to take corrective measures with the Track.

The Clerk of the Course reported at 11h30 that the Track has been rolled, however, the Jockeys expressed their reluctance to ride in Race 5. At the same time, it began to rain heavily again.

In view of the foregoing, the Stewards decided to cancel the remaining races of Race Meeting 43.



Other comments/Explanations:

- 1. Pre-race blood specimens were taken from all starters and all returned negative.
- 2. In all races, the riders were weighed in.
- 3. All the winners were selected for the taking of specimens for analysis, as well as UNITED PRINCE (Race 4).
- 4. All riders were breathalyzed and cleared to race.
